



# WiFi Hotspot Checkout Agreement

**Use of a library hotspot is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this checkout agreement, and by checking out the hotspot, you have agreed to the following:**

- I understand that the hotspot can only be checked out by a Livingston County Library card holder in good standing. Children under the age of 18 must have a signed Wi-Fi Hotspot Unfiltered Internet Access Agreement on file for their library card.
- I understand that the hotspot can be checked out for 7 days and may only be renewed 1 time if there is no waiting list. The hotspot must be returned to the library by the due date with all included accessories. If the hotspot is not returned within 24 hours of the due date, the Wi-Fi service will be disconnected and the hotspot will no longer be usable. *Failure to return the device will result in a \$200 replacement charge.* The library reserves the right to refuse checkout to patrons who abuse the hotspots or repeatedly return them late.
- I understand that the hotspot runs on the Sprint network and that the speed and availability of the Wi-Fi connection will be dependent on the service area of Sprint’s towers. Service connection is not guaranteed in all areas.
- I understand that the hotspot may NOT be returned in the bookdrop; it must be returned to the front desk. If I do not return the hotspot to the library in good working condition with all included accessories, I will be charged a replacement cost of \$200.
- I understand that there is no Internet filtering software on the hotspots. My use of the hotspot is subject to Sprint’s Acceptable Use Policy, Privacy Policy and Terms of Use, as well as the library’s Patron Acceptable Internet Use Policy.
- I understand that the library is not responsible for any files, data, or personal information accessed, transmitted, lost or damaged while accessing the Internet via the hotspot.

**By signing this agreement, I accept the above checkout agreement and am stating that I am responsible for returning this equipment to the library in good working condition and free from damage.**

# Wi-Fi Hotspot Unfiltered Internet Access Agreement

The Livingston County Library provides access to Wi-Fi hotspot devices to library card holders in good standing. These devices allow patrons to access wireless internet at home or on the go. However, unlike the public access computers that patrons may utilize while in the library, these hotspots have no filtering software in place. Parents/guardians are responsible for monitoring what their children access while using the hotspots. Therefore, children under the age of 18 must have parent or guardian permission in order check out these mobile hotspots.

**By signing below, I give permission for my child to check out mobile hotspots. I understand that there is no Internet content filtering in place on the hotspot and that I am responsible for what my child accesses on the Internet while using the hotspot. If the hotspot is not returned or is returned damaged, a \$200 replacement fee will be charged.**
